



# The Honorary Rangers Sunset Serenade

*16-19 September 2009: Letaba camp  
Kruger National Park*

The Honorary Rangers of the Counter Poaching & Rangers Support Services unit of the South African National Parks, invite you to join us for an extended weekend of music in the majestic surrounds of the beautifully shaded Letaba Rest camp in the Kruger National Park.

The extended weekend will begin on Wednesday 16th where you will settle in and no activities are scheduled. The remaining 3 nights will be filled with exquisite bush views and sunsets as we depart from the Letaba camp on open vehicles to 3 separate, secluded and unique sites in the Letaba landscape. Where you will enjoy leisurely sundowners and listen to beautiful classical and light popular music played by musicians from the Johannesburg Philharmonic Orchestra. (At each of these sites guests will be well protected by professionally trained field rangers.) After each concert a delicious 3-course dinner will be served at the Restaurant overlooking the river.

For those of you who prefer to enjoy the camp settings rather than taking the intrepid path of game viewing during the day, the musicians will be rehearsing on the lawns of the camp. All guests are welcome to listen to these and to take the opportunity to interact with the musicians.

Accommodation varies from the 2-3 bed air-conditioned chalets and for those of you wanting a more rustic experience, 4-bed luxury tents are also available with ablution facilities nearby. Most units are equipped with utensils and kitchenettes. For units without a kitchenette, there are field kitchens conveniently placed nearby with access to continuous boiling water.

Tariffs range from R3,500 p/person for the 4-bed tents to R5,200 p/person for the river view bungalows and R5,000 per person for the bungalows not on the perimeter. There are a few river view bungalows without kitchenettes. We regret that in all types of accommodation, single guests will be charged the base price plus 50%.

Bookings can be made via email or telephonically to Margaret Stafford (details below). Due to the enormous demand and limited accommodation, reservations will only be confirmed upon payment, and receipt via fax of the deposit slip. Therefore bookings are done on a 'first come-first serve' policy. (A cancellation fee of 15% will be charged for cancellations up to 30 days before the event, thereafter 100% of the fee will be forfeited for cancellations.)

**All net proceeds will be utilized for the procurement of essential equipment for the Rangers and Counter Poaching teams in all of our National Parks.**
